



Care Sheet

Now that you have made the purchase...

How to plant...

Place plants in a hole deep enough to accommodate the roots. Bone meal will encourage root growth but is not necessary and not recommended if you have a puppy around. Pack soil in tightly around roots and up to but not covering the crown (where the leaves meet the roots). Water thoroughly.

Note: the outer leaves will die off but new ones will emerge from the center.

Requirements...



Sunshine – at least 8 hours a day; full sun is fabulous

Fertilize – if you want to. I have been neglectful at times and it doesn't seem to make much of a difference whether I feed them or not.



Water – Daylilies are drought tolerant so let mother nature do the watering (unless severe drought conditions exist but then you probably shouldn't be watering your gardens anyway).

Verbal communication – occasional Ooohs and Aaahs will encourage blooming.
